**Update for the Chadwick End Annual Assembly Meeting**  
**Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> May 2026**

Since my last update for the Parish Council, I have continued to work both in Parliament and across the Meriden and Solihull East constituency to champion the issues that matter most to local communities like Chadwick End. A key priority of mine has been responding directly to residents' concerns and ensuring these are reflected in my discussions with local authorities and ministers. I remain committed to being visible, accessible, and actively engaged on the matters that affect daily life in our villages, including through surveys such as the speeding survey I did in Chadwick End.

Planning and development pressures continue to be a significant concern for residents, particularly where proposals risk undermining the character of rural communities and placing strain on already stretched infrastructure. I have consistently raised the importance of protecting the green belt and ensuring that any new development is accompanied by the right supporting services, including roads, transport, schools, and healthcare. While housing delivery is important, it must be carried out in the right places and in a way that respects local identity and residents' views. I will continue to scrutinise local plan proposals closely and support communities in making their voices heard through consultation processes.

Alongside this, I have been working with residents and Solihull Council on practical local issues, including road safety. Following feedback from residents in Chadwick End about speeding along the Warwick Road, I wrote to residents to gather their views and share ideas for potential traffic calming measures. These responses have helped inform discussions with the council and the police. This includes several residents raising concerns about the lack of a pedestrian crossing in Chadwick End. Beyond these issues, I have continued to bring people together through regular constituency events, including my business forum, pensioners' fair, and opportunities for young people to connect with employers and training providers through my careers fair. These events are designed to ensure residents across all ages can access support, advice, and opportunities close to home.
